January 29 | Sermon Notes

**Message discussion:** What stood out to you in this week's message? Questions? A way God moved you to respond?

**Passage reflection:** Read Exodus 3-4. What stands out to you in these verses? Is there something you hear God saying to you? How can you respond to what He is saying?

**1.** Read the following verses: Exodus 2:10-14; 23-25; 3:1-6; 4:10-15. How would you rate Moses' level of self-confidence? Think about his life prior to his encounter with God. What circumstances might have contributed to his being so uncertain and insecure?

**2.** What was it about the conversation with Moses that caused God's anger to burn toward Moses (Exodus 4:1-14)? Read Numbers 12:3. How did God use the weakness of Moses, his lack of self-confidence, as a vessel to display His power?

**3.** Read Exodus 33:16-23 & Exodus 34:5-9. Think about an area in your life where you feel uncertain or insecure. How does God feel about you because of that? Will He abandon you or stay with you despite your weakness and sin?

**4.** Read Philippians 3:8 & Hebrews 11:23-26. Describe what makes knowing Christ more valuable to you than anything else. Describe one thing in your life that you need to consider, or "count" as garbage in comparison to the treasure of knowing Jesus.
