



Sermon Notes | Matthew 11:28-30

Message discussion: What stood out to you in this week's message? Questions? A way God moved you to respond?

Passage reflection: Read Matthew 11:28-30. What stands out to you in these verses? Is there something you hear God saying to you? How can you respond to what He is saying?

1. Read the following verses: Hebrews 3:14 through 4:10. The writer refers to unbelief and belief as the reasons people do or don't enter God's "rest." Belief or unbelief in what?

2. Read the following verses: Galatians 3:1-5, 13-14 & Galatians 5:1-6. Paul urges us to stand firm in freedom and not submit again to a "yoke of slavery." What kind of slavery is he referring to?

3. How do you feel God looks at you, as a child loved in spite of their filth or as a child He loves because you are righteous?

4. Read the following verses:

Romans 8:1-4, 2 Corinthians 5:17-19; Ephesians 2:1-10.
Is your soul at rest in Christ, or do you still find yourself working for God's approval? What promise from God can you hold onto to rest more fully in His grace?
