



April 3 Sermon Notes

Message discussion: What stood out to you in this week's message? Questions? A way God moved you to respond?

Passage reflection: Read Colossians 1:15-20. What stands out to you in these verses? Is there something you hear God saying to you? How can you respond to what He is saying?

1. Read the following verses: Romans 14:9; 2 Corinthians 5:15; Colossians 1:18. If we see Christ as our Savior but not as having "first place in everything," how might that affect the way we live our lives?

2. Read the following verses: Romans 8:19-25 and Colossians 1:19-20. When Paul talks about "all things" being reconciled to Christ in Col. 1:20, is he teaching universal salvation, the idea that, eventually, everyone goes to heaven? Why or why not?

3. Christ is sovereign over everything. He is the one in whom all fulness dwells. AND, He has chosen to reconcile you to Himself. Does the absolute authority and supremacy of Jesus increase or decrease your feeling of intimacy with Him? Explain.

4. Jesus is to have first place in everything. Describe one area that you could more fully surrender to Him.
