Sermon Notes | Exodus 23:33-44; Deuteronomy 14:22-26

**Message discussion:** What stood out to you in this week's message? Questions? A way God moved you to respond?

**Passage reflection:** Read Exodus 23:33-44 & Deuteronomy 14:22-26. What stands out to you in these verses? Is there something you hear God saying to you? How can you respond to what He is saying?

**1.** Read Leviticus 23:37-44. God instructs the people to, "rejoice before the Lord" and to "celebrate." for seven days during the feast of booths. What do you think their celebration looked like? What does a celebration look like when you have one?

**2.** Read Deuteronomy 14:22-26. How does this passage influence your perspective on how the Israelites celebrated before the Lord? How can eating and drinking with friends and family make a celebration richer and more meaningful?

**3.** How is the practice of celebrating the Lord with other believers restful for the heart? Why do you think that kind of celebration has waned?

**4.** Read Acts 2:46-47. Do you find the idea of partying with other believers "before the Lord" exciting or uncomfortable? Explain. Is there a step you could take toward intentionally finding rest through celebrating with other believers?
